As Director of Aboriginal Service Change, and in one of two positions, available, you will take a key strategic leadership role on advancing and implementing the service delivery change agenda, aligning the provincial and regional strategies based on the framework's principles and goals.

Engagement, relationship building, collaboration and facilitation are all fortés of yours that will come into play as you work closely and respectfully with key partners within Aboriginal communities and organizations, members of the Leadership Team, senior management as well as service providers.

As such, you bring a fundamental, comprehensive and first-hand understanding of indigenous peoples, their experiences, opportunities and challenges. This is supported by a related degree (e.g. in political science, social work, Aboriginal studies, public/business administration or law) and at least three years' recent, progressive related experience, preferably with/in Aboriginal organizations.

Preference will be given to qualified applicants who self-identify as having Aboriginal status. Ideally, you're also experienced in one of the following: leading complex, multi-party negotiations with First Nations, federal government or social service agencies; developing strategic and business planning processes and planning/evaluation measurement tools; and leading/managing projects-
